
Sales Tax Received in May 2023 (April 2023 processing)

- County's General Sales Tax is <u>Up 2.52%</u> for this month compared to the same month in 2022 or <u>up \$32,688.93</u> in 1984 voter approved General Fund portion and <u>Up 6.13%</u> year-to-date compared to the same period in 2022 or <u>up \$254,477.52</u> (March 2023 processing through February 2024 processing).
- Thirteen of the top fifty remitters went unprocessed for an average total of \$83,991 and four of the previous twelve unprocessed remitters did not catch up with amounts close to double their monthly average for an average total of \$21,548. The top fifty remitters represent 53.14% of tax receipts.
- 1984 voter approved General Fund potion of Sales Tax for 2023 is projected to be \$18,777,938 which is at 99.87% of budget or \$24,862 below 2023 general revenue Fund 101 budget of \$18,802,800 and \$8,817 above 2022 actual. While year-to-date sales tax is up compared to same period last year two of the three months included in year-to-date are typically below the 12-month average. This explains why the current year-end estimate (3 months actual + 9 months at 12-month average) is less than budget.

Trend Lines

The 3-Month trend line decreased 0.22% this month while the 12-Month line decreased 0.26% decreasing the gap from -0.787% to -0.744%. The trend lines crossed six months ago. This crossing of the trend lines signals a transition from a period of increasing growth to a period of a decline in growth.

Receipts this year, for economic periods in this year, are now up 14.99% (the overall 6.13% increase mentioned above includes receipts for April 2022 through March 2023) to what we knew at the same time last year.
