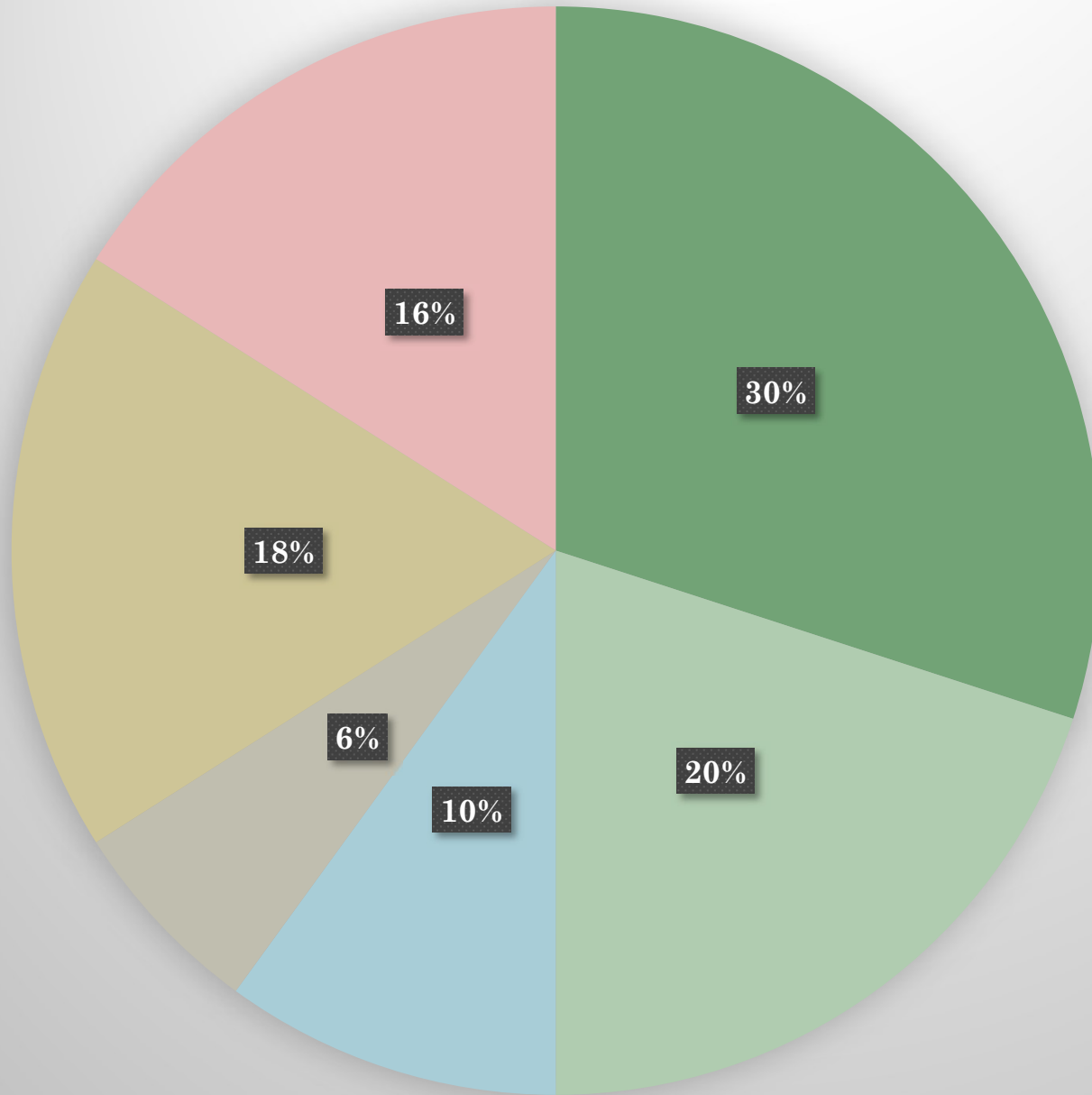

Funding



- The Park Board receives **NO** funding from the City OR County.
- Parks Sales Tax and Property Tax are dedicated revenue streams- Can only be used for parks.
- We actually pay the City \$700,000/year
- Golf is self-funded through our Enterprise Fund.

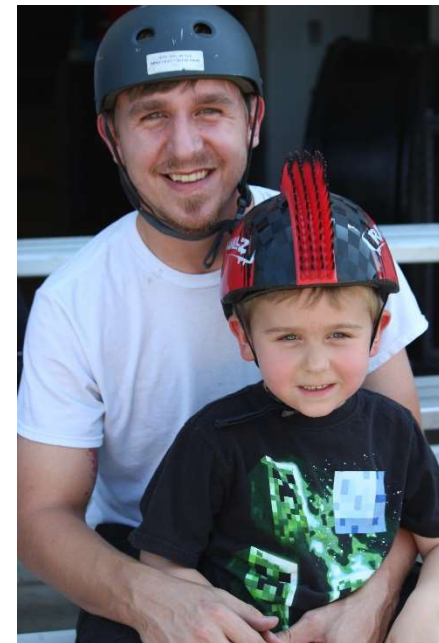
