- What types of innovations are we looking for?
 - Innovations must fall within these two categories:
 - Tools and Equipment includes items fabricated or modified by Highway employees.



- What types of innovations are we looking for?
 - Innovations must fall within these two categories:
 - Tools and Equipment includes items fabricated or modified by Highway employees.
 - Productivity includes office and field processes, materials, and products.



- Do I need to select a category for my innovation?
 - · NO.
 - Entry form does not require you to select a category.
 - CHIPs coordinators will assign innovations to categories



- Can I submit an innovation shared by more than one area of the department?
 - Yes, but be sure to include the names of all department employees involved with developing and implementing your innovation.



- Why was my submission considered ineligible?
 - An innovation that has not been piloted to show desired results.
 - An innovation considered routine throughout the department.
 - An innovation considered to be unsafe.
 - An innovation that replicates a patented item.

 - Organization Impact how will it impact performance?




- How long does my innovation need to be implemented?

 No. All work on innovations should be performed at a normal department work site.










