DISCUSSION

Freezing rain and perhaps brief sleet will move into Western Missouri as early as 9pm and the rest of the area at midnight, increasing across the area through Monday morning. Ice will accumulate on surfaces and elevated areas, causing hazardous travel conditions through the Monday morning commute. Total ice amounts of a glaze to 1/10 inch is expected north of I-44, with 1/10 to 2/10 inch along and south of I-44. Localized areas south of Springfield could reach ¼ inch, potentially impacting power supplies.

Freezing rain will slowly transition to rain by Monday afternoon.

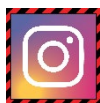
