Fire Weather Risk

Red Flag Warning in effect today from 1200 hrs to 2100 hrs.

HAZARD	Feb-08	Feb-09
Fire Weather	SIGNIFICANT	LIMITED
Grassland Fire Danger Index	EXTREME (50-75)	VERY HIGH

DISCUSSION

Wind Gusts: Southwest at 20-30 mph gusting to 35-45 mph.

Humidity (%): 25% - 30%

Impacts: Any fires that develop will likely spread rapidly. Outdoor burning is NOT recommended.

A Red Flag Warning means that critical fire weather conditions are either occurring now or will shortly. A combination of strong winds, low relative humidity, and warm temperatures can contribute to extreme fire behavior. Short term concerns center around strong winds and very dry air (wildfire potential) today.

THREAT RECOMMENDATIONS

Be cautious with heat sources and avoid outdoor burning.

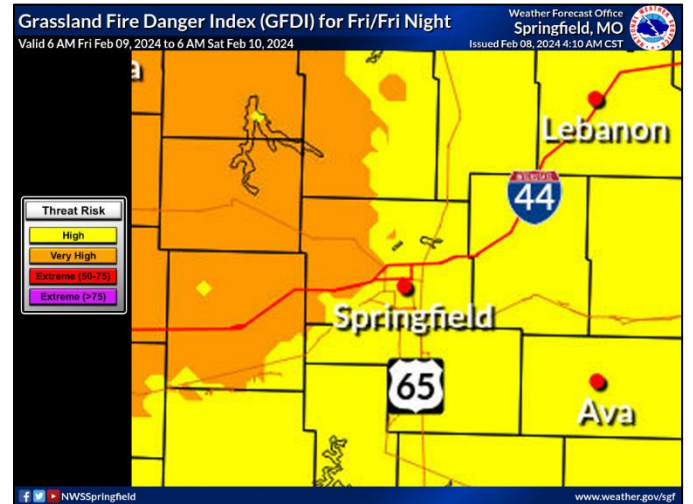
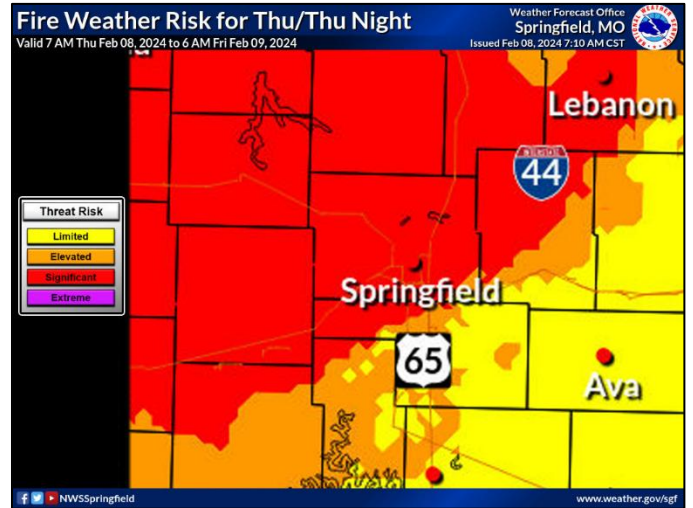
