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




Bridge Inspection History

In 2022 a total of 218 Greene County bridge evaluations were completed during the bridge inspection cycle





















Summary

- 93% of Greene County bridges were appraised as "non deficient" in the 2022 inspection cycle. That number improved with recent new construction.
- All bridge condition ratings were at a 4 or greater.
