9-1-1 Advisory Board Meeting March 20, 2024

- 1. CALL TO ORDER The Greene County 9-1-1 Advisory Board was called to order by Chair Pennington on March 20, 2024, via phone conference call. Seven board members were in attendance. *Attendance details in Attachment*.
- 2. APPROVAL –February 21, 2024 Meeting Minutes Pennington indicated a draft of the meeting minutes were distributed to the board members for review prior to the meeting. Williams motioned to approve the minutes; Schrader seconded. Motion carried 7/0.

3. STATUS UPDATES

Financial Reports - The written report, for the January Financials, was presented by Budget Officer Jeff Scott. January represents 8.3% of the year. Sales tax is behind pace at 7.3%. All other categories are ahead of pace. Overall, revenue is ending the month behind pace at 7.6%. Personnel expenditures were 6.7% compared to 2 of 26 pay periods being 7.7%. Vacancy is on pace to be \$890,291 better then budget of \$275,000. Operations are at 2%. Springfield Plaza TIF is ahead of pace. When you combine Personnel & Operations, expenditures are better than pace at 5.5%. Capital, Debt Service and Contingency is at 0%. Overall, total expenditures are better than pace at 4.7%. We have not experienced any of the large one-time expenses (Gen.Liability, Telephone, Spfld All OvrHd, CAD System Maint, Equipment) yet. Adjusted YTD Overall Budget is \$791,554.87 and Adjusted Overall YTD Spending is \$466,197 for a \$325,358 volume to the good through 1 month.

Cash balance at the end of January 2024 was \$8,844,297 in the warrant account. This is \$1,268,839 higher than last year. Cash level (less outstanding warrants of 547,296) is 3.94 times the required operating reserve level of \$2,105,054.

Ford noted they are currently working on a CAD upgrade and working on a grant to add Mercy Hospital to our system.
- **B. P1CAD and Statistics Update –Webb** Webb noted 95.5% of calls are being answered within 15 seconds. He stated they are currently working on NextGen implementation.
