9-1-1 Advisory Board Meeting April 17, 2024

- 1. CALL TO ORDER The Greene County 9-1-1 Advisory Board was called to order by Vice Chair Coulter on April 17, 2024, via phone conference call. Six board members were in attendance. *Attendance details in Attachment*.
- 2. APPROVAL –March 20, 2024 Meeting Minutes Coulter indicated a draft of the meeting minutes were distributed to the board members for review prior to the meeting. Schrader motioned to approve the minutes; Williams seconded. Motion carried 6/0.

3. STATUS UPDATES

Financial Reports - The written report, for the February Financials, was presented by Budget Officer Jeff Scott. February represents 17% of the year. Sales tax is behind pace at 15%. All other categories are ahead of pace. Overall, revenue is ending the month behind pace at 15%. Personnel expenditures were 16.2% compared to 5 of 26 pay periods being 19.2%. Vacancy is on pace to be \$998,616 better then budget of \$275,000. Operations are at 6%. Equipment Lease and Springfield Plaza TIF are ahead of pace. When you combine Personnel & Operations, expenditures are better than pace at 13.9%. Capital, Debt Service and Contingency is at 0%. Overall, total expenditures are better than pace at 11.9%. We have only experienced Equipment Lease and not any of our large one-time expenses (Gen.Liability, Telephone, Spfld All OvrHd, CAD System Maint, Equipment) yet. Adjusted YTD Overall Budget is \$1,834,367 and Adjusted Overall YTD Spending is \$1,151,788 for a \$682,579 volume to the good through 2 months.

Cash balance at the end of February 2024 was \$8,740,592 in the warrant account. This is \$798,455 higher than last year. Cash level (less outstanding warrants of 969) is 4.15 times the required operating reserve level of \$2,105,054.
