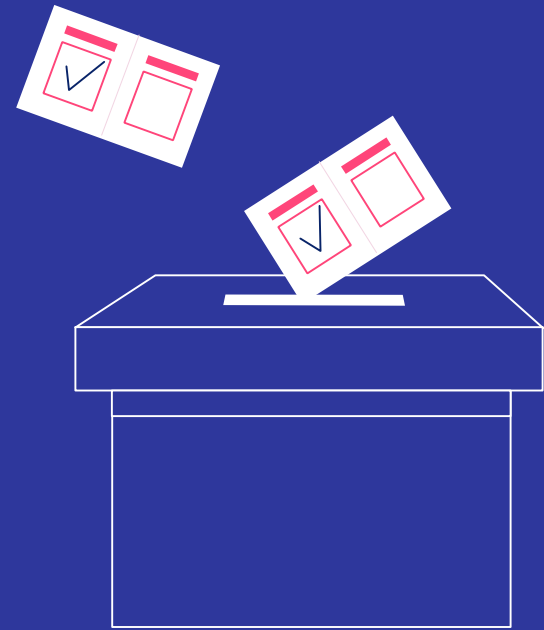

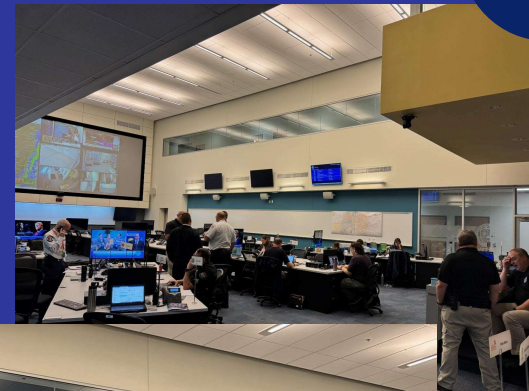


# Emergency Operations Center (EOC) Activation

The County Clerk's Office worked with the Office of Emergency Management to prepare for the Election, along with 14 plus agencies.

Sample Incidents that were resolved on Election Day:

- Power Outage at a Polling Location
- Water Main Break near a Polling Location





# Line Management

No-Excuse Absentee Voting begin on October 22, 2024.

The first day of No Excuse, the Library Center saw 881 voters.

Fast forward to November 4, the Library Center saw 1,508 voters that day.

The office along with the Springfield-Greene County Library and Greene County Sheriff's Department worked together to design efficient queues in response to the high turnout.





# Ballot On-Demand

In 2024, Greene County procured 20 PollPrint units, which are mobile ballot on-demand systems.

For in-person absentee, 20,000 ballots were ordered. In just the first few days of no-excuse absentee voting, we quickly realized turnout was going to be higher than anticipated.

The PollPrint units were able to be deployed to all three absentee voting locations to ensure minimal to no ballot shortages.

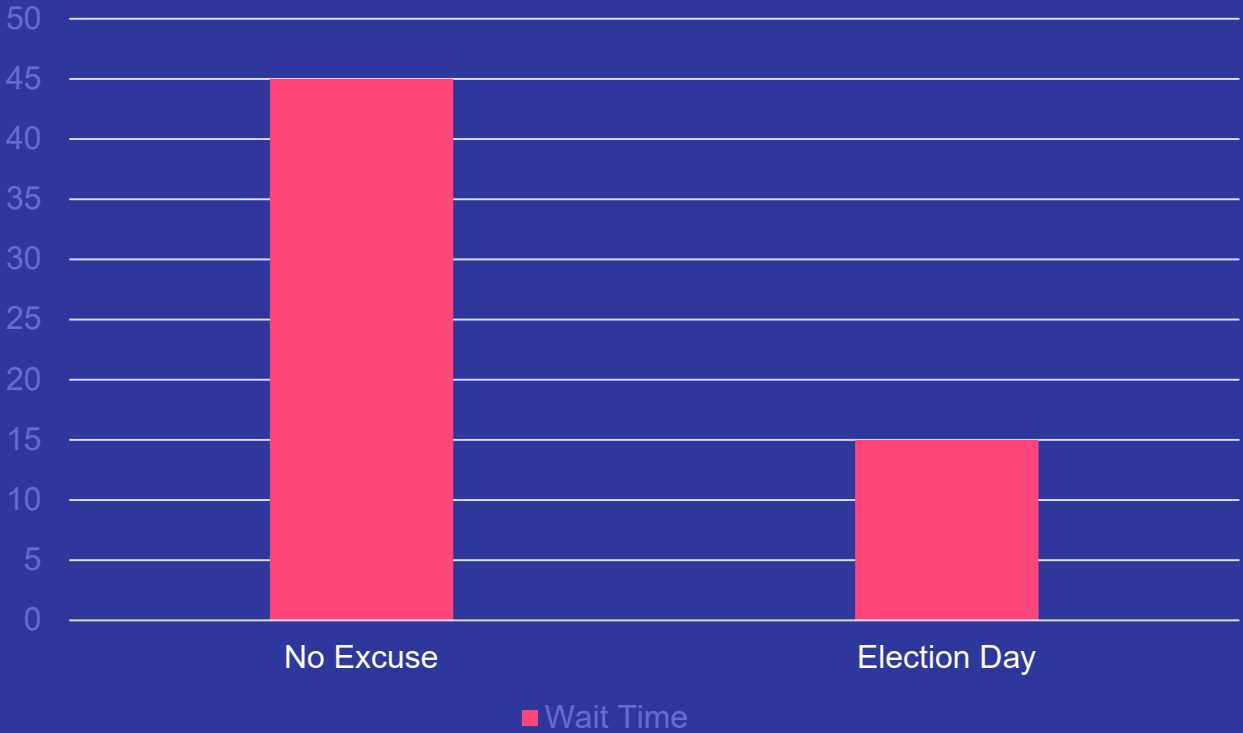

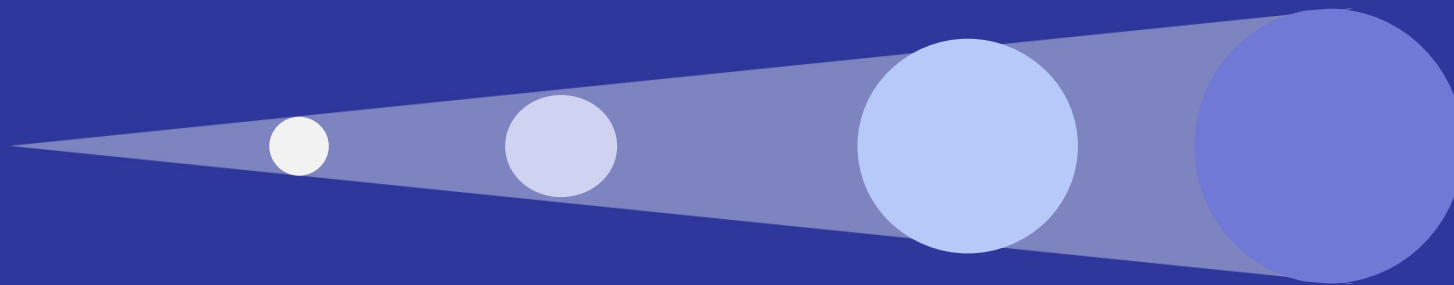

## Improved Chain of Custody

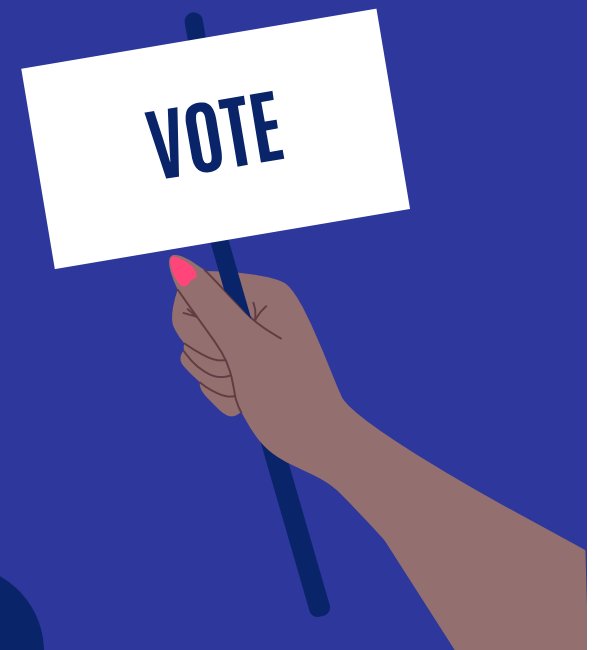
As the County grows, so does the equipment needs to facilitate an election. The Office is currently looking at improved tracking of voting equipment for chain of custody, such as RFID tracking.
