DISCUSSION

Mixed precipitation is expected overnight tonight. Total sleet and snow accumulations up to one inch and ice accumulations from a light glaze up to a tenth of an inch.

A lingering wintry mix will be possible in the Eastern Ozarks Tuesday Morning. Snow will be possible north of Highway 60 at times during the day and will potentially contain bands of snow. A dusting to two inches of snow is possible within these bands, with localized amounts of up to four inches possible.

A second, stronger system will move through the region on Wednesday. An additional hazard report will be issued as more details are known for that system.
