### DISCUSSION

Areas of drizzle and freezing drizzle tonight ahead of the main system.

In Wednesday's system, there is a greater chance of freezing rain and/or sleet along the corridor parallel to I-44 with the highest accumulations across the eastern Ozarks. Expect accumulations of a glaze to 0.20". The greatest snow threat is along and north of Highway 54. Two to four inches is expected. Mostly rain is expected along the Missouri-Arkansas border within lower terrain.

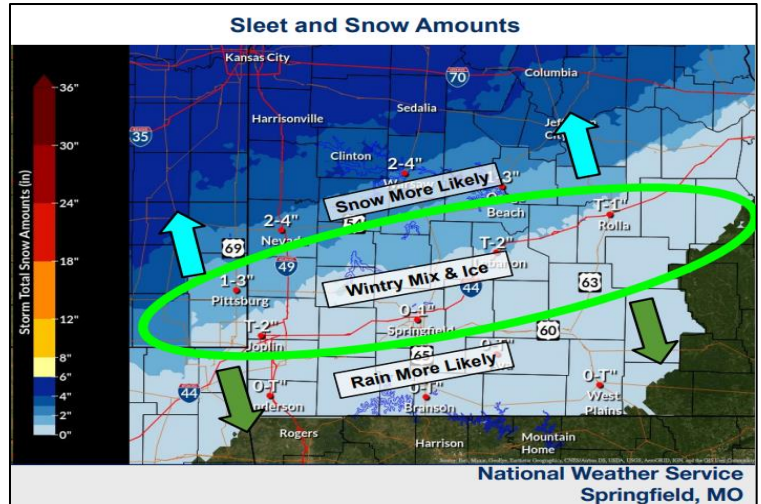
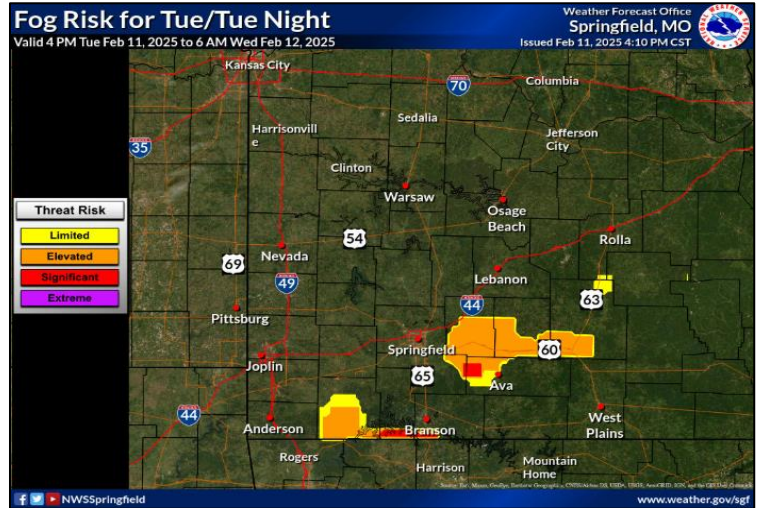
