DISCUSSION

A major winter storm will impact the entire area Tuesday into Wednesday. A Winter Storm Warning has been issued.

Heavy snow is expected with total snowfall amounts between 6-10 inches. Localized amounts of up to 14 inches in higher snow bands.

Travel impacts and closures are likely with this system due to the amount of snow and blowing/drifting snow. Visibility may drop below 1/4 mile due to falling and blowing snow. Travel could be very difficult to impossible. The hazardous conditions could impact the Tuesday morning and evening commutes.

There is high confidence in dangerously cold temperatures and wind chills Tuesday through Thursday.

 - Practice generator safety and only use outside of home
