DISCUSSION

Wind: 15-25 mph with gusts up to 40 mph

Humidity (%): As low as 20%

Any fire that develops will catch and spread Impacts: quickly. Outdoor burning is not recommended.

Red flag conditions will be possible today across the area as humidity levels dip into the teens to mid-20s and wind gusts of 30 to 40 mph will be possible. A red flag warning has been issued for the entire area from 1000 to 2000 hrs.

THREAT RECOMMENDATIONS

Be cautious with heat sources and avoid outdoor burning.
