DISCUSSION

Wind Gusts: Up to 35 mph

Humidity (%): 20-30% localized as low as 15%

Impacts: Winds are expected to increase this evening continuing into Friday.

Significant fire weather conditions expected on Friday afternoon for most of Greene County. Maximum southwest to west wind gusts of 25 to 35 mph, with minimum afternoon humidities around 15 to 30 percent. A Red Flag Warning has been issued for portions of southwest Missouri on Friday afternoon.

THREAT RECOMMENDATIONS

Be cautious with heat sources and avoid outdoor burning.

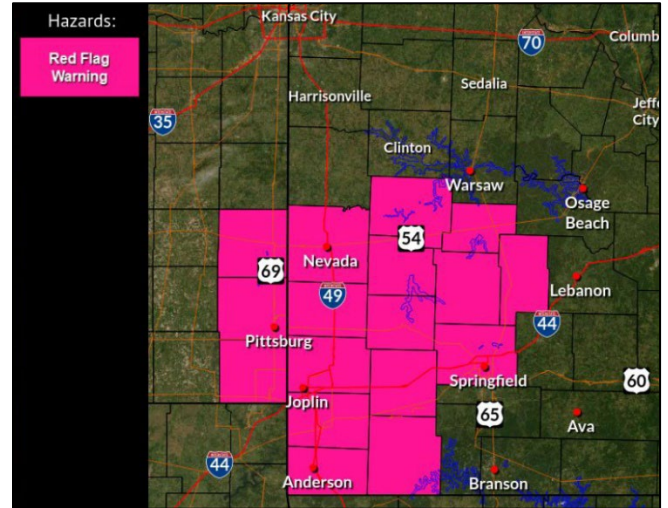
