#### **Fire Weather Risk**

Red Flag Warning and High Wind Warning are in effect from 10 am Friday to 1 am Saturday.

#### DISCUSSION

Wind Gusts: Southerly 30-40 mph gusting up to 50-60 mph

**Humidity (%):** As low as 10-25%

Impacts:
Outdoor burning is strongly discouraged.
Dry lightning strikes may cause ignitions.

Critical to extreme fire danger conditions will exist across most of the area today into tonight due to dry air, strong winds, and dry ground cover fuels. Fires will spread very quickly with spot fires common. Fire control will be extremely difficult. Showers and thunderstorms are expected this afternoon and evening along and ahead of the dry line, but the coverage is expected to be limited for most of the area in the Red Flag Warning. It's quite possible that most areas in the warning remain dry. If thunderstorms do form, fire crews should be prepared for lightning and severe weather including very strong winds, large hail (potentially up to baseball size), and tornadoes.

## THREAT RECOMMENDATIONS

Be cautious with heat sources and avoid outdoor burning.
