DISCUSSION

Northeast to East 20-35 mph gusting up to 45-55 Wind Gusts:

Humidity (%): As low as 20-30%

Impacts: Outdoor burning is strongly discouraged.

Elevated fire weather conditions will exist today as a cold front moves through the Ozarks. A red flag warning is in effect as brief periods of relative humidities in the 20-30 percent range will combine with gusty winds. Winds will gust to 45-55 mph into this evening with a wind advisory in effect from 8am-8pm. There is a 40 to 75 percent chance of light snow paired with the breezy winds this evening into tonight. The highest chances are toward central Missouri.

THREAT RECOMMENDATIONS

Be cautious with heat sources and avoid outdoor burning.

During high winds travel may become difficult for high-profile vehicles. Loose objects may be blown around. Small limbs may break and fall.

Red Flag Warning Today Gusty Winds and Low Relative Humidities **Maximum Wind Gusts** 45 - 55 mph Minimum Relative Humidity 20 - 30% read rapidly in these conditions and trol will be extremely difficult. Outside burning is strongly discouraged. 40 AM - 3 PM 6 AM - 11 AM Avoid activities that cause open flames or sparks. Properly discard of cigarettes. Avoid parking on dry grass and check trailers for dragging chains.
