#### DISCUSSION

High confidence in multiple rounds of heavy rainfall through this weekend. Increasing confidence in this resulting in potentially significant flooding. Today into Saturday look to be the most impactful days. A Flood Watch remains in effect along and southeast of Interstate 44.

#### CITIZEN ACTION STATEMENT

- Have a severe weather shelter plan. Review your emergency kit and identify the closest safe shelter.
- Have a way of receiving severe weather warnings (NOAA Weather Radio, social media, news media, etc.)
- Take shelter when lightning is in the area.
- **“When thunder roars . . . go indoors!”**
- Citizens with outdoor recreational plans along rivers and streams should be alert for the potential for lightning strikes and rapidly rising water levels.

**“Turn around . . . don’t drown!”**
