



# Springfield-Greene County Park Board Revenue

Voter-approved Countywide Parks Sales Taxes:


#### 2001 1/4-cent:

1/8-cent for Capital Projects, sunset in 2006

1/8-cent for Operation of Capital Projects, continuous Generates approximately \$7.5 million/year

#### 2006 ¼-cent:

1/8-cent for Capital Projects, sunset in in 2011 1/8-cent for Operation of Capital Projects, continuous Generates approximately \$7.5 million/year

Parks has had no dedicated capital funding source since 2011

Cooper Park/Lake Country Soccer Reinvestment

## \$28 million improvements underway Phase 1


- Turf 8 soccer fields COMPLETE
- Approximate cost: \$11M

#### Phase 2

- Turf 6 baseball, 5 softball fields
- In progress, estimated completion in late 2025
- Approximate cost: \$17.5M



# Cooper Park/Lake Country Soccer Reinvestment



### Silver Springs Park Pavilion Renovation

- \$1.5 million improvements
- Pavilion renovation with amphitheater seating, A/V equipment
- Completed July 2025
- Collaboration with **Neighborhood Coalition** and Greene County

# McDaniel Park Pump Track

- Phase 1 Design and construction of Pump Track, parking lot and driveway.
- Phase 2 Design and construction of pavilion with restrooms, and pump track lighting.
- Phase 3 Replace and update playground, addl. park lighting.




Dickerson Park Zoo Bear Boardwalk replacement

- Replacing boardwalk built in 1989, adding gazebo over bear viewing area.
- Estimated cost: \$589,000.
- \$580,000 is covered by City of Springfield carryover funding.
- Began June 2025, estimated completion December 2025.









## **Priority Capital Projects**

- Meador Park: Pickleball court expansion
- Neighborhood park playground improvements
- Fieldhouse Sportscenter court expansion
- Trail connectivity Ungap the map
- Landscape, signage and beautification



#### Pickleball at Meador Park

- Phase 1 Large shade structure with restrooms and storage.
- Phase 2 Replace 12
   pickleball courts,
   adding shade
   structures with picnic
   tables and bleachers.



Phase 3 Replace basketball court with 4 to 6 new pickleball courts.
