DISCUSSION

Tuesday

Showers and thunderstorms are likely from 6:00 am to 9:00 pm with the greater chance between 3:00 pm to 4:00 pm. Chance of precipitation is 80%. Rainfall amounts between a 1/2" and 3/4" possible.

Tuesday Night into Wednesday Morning

Showers likely and possibly a thunderstorm. Chance of precipitation is 80%. Rainfall amount between a 1/2" and 3/4" possible.

CITIZEN ACTION STATEMENT

- Have a severe weather shelter plan. Review your emergency kit and identify the closest safe shelter.
- Have a way of receiving severe weather warnings (NOAA Weather Radio, social media, news media, etc.)
- Take shelter when lightning is in the area.
- "When thunder roars . . . go indoors!"**
- Citizens with outdoor recreational plans along rivers and streams should be alert for the potential for lightning strikes and rapidly rising water levels.

"Turn around . . . don't drown!"
