
What is LAGERS?

- ► LAGERS: Missouri Local Government Employees Retirement System
- Mission: To support a secure retirement for our members by partnering with Missouri's local governments to provide a sustainable defined benefit plan.
- Vision: To enhance the lives of our members by promoting financial stability for their Future.

Greene County LAGERS Information

- Benefit Program: L-7 1.5% Lifetime
- Employer Contribution Rate
 - 2020: General 8.4% Police 11.5%
 - 2025: General 9.1% Police 13.3%
- Percentage Funded
 - General 100% Police 84%
- Active Members
 - General: 765 Police: 253

Retirees and Beneficiaries Added and Removed



Greene County by the Numbers

- Average Annual Pay
 - General: Approx. \$59,000 Police: Approx. \$69,000
- Average Age
 - General & Police: 41-42
- Average Years of Service
 - General & Police: 7 years
- Vested Former Employees:
 - General: 502
 - ► Police: 111

Retirement

- You are vested after 60 months (5 years) of service credits
- Retirement Age
 - Normal: 60 for general and 55 for police and fire
 - 5 years before for early retirement
- There is a reduction in benefit if you choose to retire early
- 1 of 6 members of LAGERS are eligible to retire within 2 years

Retirement (cont'd)

- Application process at least 30 days, but no more than 90 days before you want your first payment
- LAGERS pays benefits on the first business day of each month
- There are a few different payment options
- You must take a month break after receiving benefits before you can start working with a LAGERS employer

Retirement (cont'd)

Update your email to a personal email in the LAGERS portal.

If you have worked for multiple LAGERS employers, the portal breaks down the service
