Process:

1. Any inmates or former inmates can go to front desk and report they were transported officers or recently released from GCJ
2. The One Door organization will conduct an informal interview to assess for needs
3. A case manager is assigned to help access resources.
4. They may then utilize the facility for the above listed services.

Identification

Driver's License or Non-Driver's ID (Missouri)

What you will need to bring:

- Social Security number
 - Do not have to have the actual card, just know your number
- Proof of name and place & date of birth
 - Birth certification, passport, or citizenship certificate
- Proof of Missouri residence
 - Any mail with your name- utility bill, pay check, or bank statement
 - They do not accept PO box addresses
- \$18 payment (cash or card)

Birth Certificates

What you will need to bring:

- \$15 payment (cash, card, check)
- Primary Form of ID [only one required]
 - State issued ID or driver's license
 - Military ID with picture
 - Current US Passport
 - School ID card with picture
 - Work ID card with name, picture, and company name
- Secondary Form of ID [two required if you don't have any of those listed in Primary Form of ID above]
 - Letter from government or social agency
 - W-2 or work paystub
 - Social Security card or printout
 - Vehicle title or registration document
 - Insurance policy (auto, home, health, life)
 - Utility bills with name and address
 - Shelter name band
 - Medicaid/Medicare document or ID card

Social Security Card

What to bring:

- Form of ID:
 - Driver's license or non-drivers ID
 - US Passport or citizenship letter
- Other accepted IDs:
 - Employee card
 - School card
 - Health insurance card
 - Medicaid card
 - Certified copy of medical records
 - US Military card

- *WILL NOT accept a birth certificate, social security card stub, or social security record*
