DISCUSSION

Two rounds of moderate to heavy snowfall will result in widespread accumulating snow. Total snow accumulations between 6 and 14 inches. Greatest amounts are expected along and south of Interstate 44 and the lowest amounts are expected across central Missouri. Areas near the Missouri and Arkansas border may see sleet mix with snow at times.

Travel could be very difficult. Very cold temperatures in the single digits with wind chill values below zero will add to the safety threat. Motorists should avoid traveling but will need to plan for cold weather survival in the event they become stranded. The dangerously cold wind chills as low as 20 below zero could cause frostbite on exposed skin in as little as 30 minutes.

- Consider a winter storm kit for your car & winterize cars.
- Bring pets indoors or to a warm dry place with plenty of food.
- Practice generator safety and only use outside of home

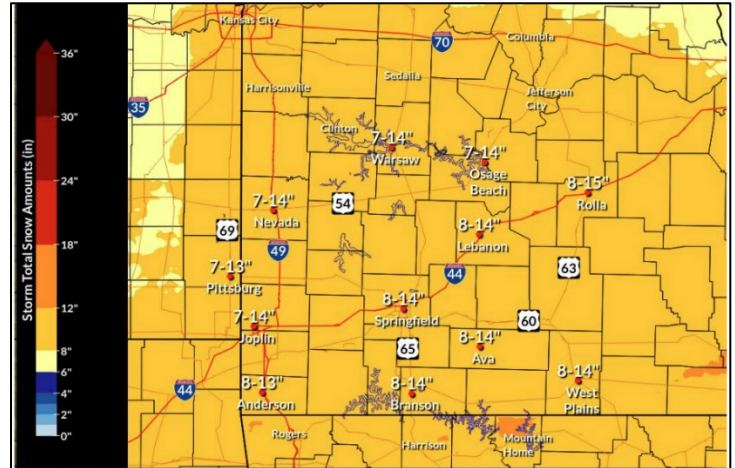

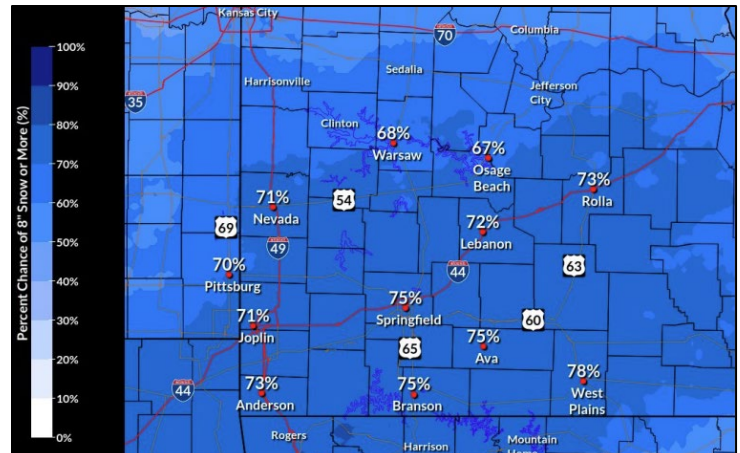
