**Sales Tax Received in March 2026 (February 2026 processing)**

County's General Sales Tax is **Up 6.94%** for this month compared to the same month in 2025 or **Up \$107,384** in 1984 voter approved General Fund portion and **Up 6.94%** year-to-date compared to the same period in 2025 or **Up \$107,384** (February 2026 processing through January 2027 processing).

- Seven of the top fifty remitters went unprocessed for an average total of \$44,645 and three of the previous month's unprocessed did not have close to twice their average this month for a total of \$23,645. The top fifty remitters represent 53.24% of tax receipts.
- Current activity suggests 1984 voter approved General Fund portion of Sales Tax for 2026 will end the year at \$19,894,181 which is at 102.55% of budget or \$494,181 above 2026 general revenue Fund 101 budget of \$19,400,000 and \$177,861 above 2025 actual.

**Trend Line**

The 3-Month trend line **increased** 0.54% this month and the 12-Month trend line **increased** 0.04% the trend lines have crossed, once again, with a now positive gap of 0.45%. This resumes the path of original expectations and the budget department is considering the activity over the past 3 months as an anomaly created by uncertainty in the economy. We are back to being in a period of expected growth in sales tax receipts.
