DISCUSSION

Wind Gusts: Sustained winds 10-15 mph, gusting up to 30 mph

Humidity (%): 23%

Impacts: Majority of Greene County

Very warm and dry air will result in Elevated fire danger today. Afternoon temperatures in the low 90s and relative humidity in the 15 to 25% range will allow fires to start easily.

Elevated to significant fire danger will occur on Sunday as a dry air mass and gusty winds will occur. A cold front will move through the area Sunday afternoon and evening. Southwesterly winds of 10 to 15 mph with gusts up to 30 mph will occur south of the front northerly winds of 15-25 mph with gusts up to 40 mph will occur behind the front.

THREAT RECOMMENDATIONS

Be cautious with heat sources and avoid outdoor burning.
