DISCUSSION

A flood watch has been issued for 1 pm Sunday to 1 pm Monday for areas along and west of Highway 63. While a widespread flooding risk is not expected, any thunderstorm will carry the potential for 1 to 3 inch per hour downpours, with localized amounts up to 5 inches possible which may lead to a very isolated flooding risk for any areas that experience a slow-moving shower.

Greater coverage of showers and thunderstorms are expected Sunday through Monday. With continued potential for high rain rates, a slight risk for excessive rainfall and subsequent flash flooding exists across southwest Missouri through Monday.

CITIZEN ACTION STATEMENT

- Have a severe weather shelter plan. Review your emergency kit and identify the closest safe shelter.
- Have a way of receiving severe weather warnings (NOAA Weather Radio, social media, news media, etc.)
- Take shelter when lightning is in the area.
- "When thunder roars . . . go indoors!"**
- Citizens with outdoor recreational plans along rivers and streams should be alert for the potential for lightning strikes and rapidly rising water levels.

"Turn around . . . don't drown!"

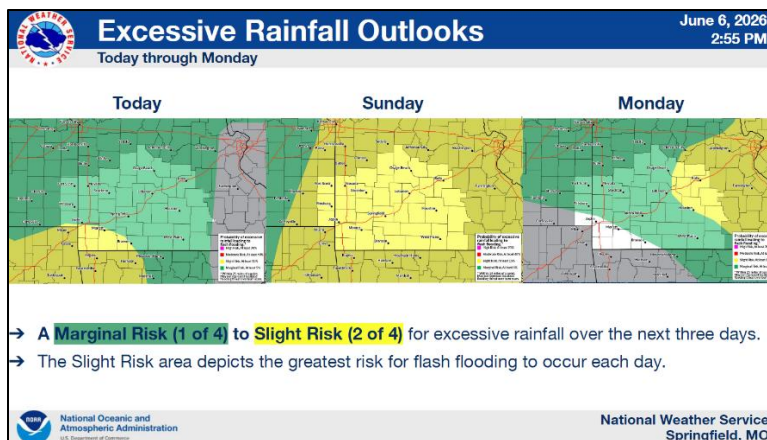
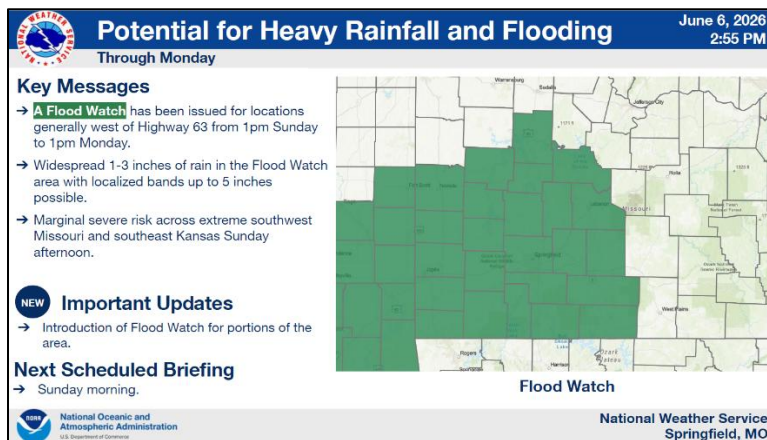
