DISCUSSION

Flood Watch is in effect from Sunday morning 1 am through Monday morning 7 am. There will be widespread rainfall amounts of 1 to 3 inches, with localized higher amounts of 3 to 5 inches. Rainfall amounts will likely be banded in nature.

Strong to severe thunderstorm potential along the cold front. Primary hazards are damaging wind gusts up to 60 mph and hail to the size of golf balls. A secondary hazard for a few tornadoes, particularly along existing outflow boundaries of the morning complex.

CITIZEN ACTION STATEMENT

- Have a severe weather shelter plan. Review your emergency kit and identify the closest safe shelter.
- Have a way of receiving severe weather warnings (NOAA Weather Radio, social media, news media, etc.)
- Take shelter when lightning is in the area.
- **"When thunder roars . . . go indoors!"**
- Citizens with outdoor recreational plans along rivers and streams should be alert for the potential for lightning strikes and rapidly rising water levels.

"Turn around . . . don't drown!"
