DISCUSSION

Marginal risk for strong-to-severe thunderstorms across southwest MO tonight into Wednesday morning. Marginal to Slight risk for flash flooding late tonight through Thursday. The greatest rainfall risk is over the areas that received heavy rainfall this past weekend.

Daily shower and thunderstorm chances persist Wednesday through Friday. An associated heavy rainfall and flash flooding risk will accompany each round. A Slight Risk for excessive rainfall and flash flooding captures this potential on Wednesday and Thursday. There is an additional Marginal Risk for isolated strong to severe thunderstorms on Wednesday.

CITIZEN ACTION STATEMENT

- Have a severe weather shelter plan. Review your emergency kit and identify the closest safe shelter.
- Have a way of receiving severe weather warnings (NOAA Weather Radio, social media, news media, etc.)
- Take shelter when lightning is in the area.
- **“When thunder roars . . . go indoors!”**
- Citizens with outdoor recreational plans along rivers and streams should be alert for the potential for lightning strikes and rapidly rising water levels.
