**“Team Greene” – Greene County Seeks Volunteers for Information Booths**

*Springfield, MO* – The Greene County Commission has announced a new volunteer program known as “Team Greene.” The purpose of “Team Greene” is to develop a group of volunteers who will work in the information booths located in the Historic Courthouse and the Judicial Courts Building.

The Greene County Commission is currently seeking volunteers for “Team Greene”. A minimum of four volunteer hours per week (all on the same day) is requested, however additional volunteer hours may be contributed up to 40 hours per week. Volunteers must be 18 years of age or older to participate. Training sessions will be provided at a date to be determined.
