# Items for Consideration and Action by the Commission

- Intergovernmental Agreement with the City of Springfield for Maintenance of Storm Sirens
  - Commissioner Bengsch moved to accept the Intergovernmental Agreement with the City of Springfield for Maintenance of Storm Sirens. Commissioner Bentley seconded. The motion was unanimously passed.

### <u>Informational Items</u>

- 1. Resource Management—Kevin Barnes
  - Kevin gave an update on code enforcement: The department has 14 cases submitted to the Greene County counsel and the cases are in the process of being resolved or taking legal action.
  - Kevin reported the software transition from the old to the new system is going
    well and is making the inspection process much easier. The inspector has
    visited all properties in the department backlog and has brought the inspections
    up to date.
  - The department is seeing new subdivisions and growth even though they aren't seeing very many new plats at this time.
  - Cox Tower Update: There are delays in working on the seventh floor since the
    offices have not yet been vacated. There is a question as to whether the July
    target date will be met.
  - Judicial Courthouse Update: Building staff have been complimentary of the construction that has taken place. The contractor has been very sensitive to the needs of staff and has tried to create as little disturbance as possible regarding noise and disruption.
  - There was a discussion of several county properties with regard to clean up.
  - Chris Coulter reported on building security issues and they are working to get those resolved.
