Springfield Fire Chief David Hall provided the meeting training. David just announced his retirement which is effective January 27. He will be the new Emergency Manager for Missouri State University.

Further fire updates included:

- A new hazmat team vehicle being put into service in March
- New organizational structure for the SFD Kelly Cardin will be the new LEPC SFD liaison
- City Council is considering closing stations # 6 and 12 due to history of calls and response times
- City of Springfield has strengthened the emergency response training today was a department-wide fire drill. Each quarter will be a new drill with pre-drill training and post-drill evaluation.

Ralph presented the 2016 Outstanding Membership Awards - 19 members were given the award this year. The award was a Bluetooth speaker.

The next LEPC General Membership meeting is scheduled for February 23, 2017 (this is a week later than the normal schedule due to community wide training in Emmitsburg, MD.)
