## MINUTES

Chief Juvenile Officer Bill Prince told the Commission that he was glad that Maily Knight was recently appointed the Human Resources Director. He said it will help develop a stronger partnership between HR and the Juvenile Office. He updated the Commission on Raise The Age, an effort in legislature to increase juvenile justice jurisdiction to include 17-year-olds. He noted that raising the age would subsequently increase funding needs for services and wages. He is concerned that this effort could lead to an unfunded mandate.

Resource Management Director Kevin Barnes gave updates on various projects around campus.
