Dan Patterson- Prosecuting Attorney

Mr. Patterson informs the Commission that on 12/21 he will be presenting a single source purchase for a program called stop the Violence. Patterson gave a brief overview of what the program will entail.

Chris Mericle-Purchasing Director

Mr. Mericle presented the Commission with a monthly status report for December 2017. There are seven new formal bids, Mr. Mericle shared some of the formal bids with the Commission. There are two current bids that are in the process which are voting equipment for the GC clerk's office and Legal Services for the Prosecutors office. Mericle also informed the audience that there were three recently completed bids and went on to highlight special projects and that the YTD purchase orders were 2,643. There was a cost savings from the move to the Cox Tower of \$1500.00.
