## MINUTES

Daily Briefing

December 28, 2017

Chris Coulter presented the Commission with a request to purchase equipment from University of Missouri to be repurposed in the morgue as it goes under County operation. The cost is approximately \$4,000. The purchase was reviewed by Cindy Stein, Jeff Scott, and Chris Mericle and they all determined it was a fair price.

Commissioner Cirtin made the motion to purchase the equipment from MU. Commissioner Hough seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Kevin Barnes informed the Commission that Country Squire Mobile Home Park now has plan for a sewer system, and the Code Enforcement Officer Lonnie Vandiver would be doing a presentation at the January 9 Huddle. He mentioned that there is a vacancy on the Planning Board. Chris Coulter noted that we currently have one applicant, Mike Lloyd. Commission Cirtin suggested that it would be nice to have some women on the board, since there currently aren't any. He said he will check with The Network, the Junior League, and Rosie, for potential applicants.

Chris Coulter said Dr. Norton has agreed to provide medical examiner services for now until a medical examiner is hired with the County. County Counsel John Housley is preparing an order to appoint Dr. Norton as M.E. for now.
