Resource Management Director Kevin Barnes updated the Commission on the Lynn Hart case. Case involved a home that had burned. The demo for this property has been delayed as the home owner has filed bankruptcy. Bankruptcy will cause for a delay and we will give her a new timeline for rebuild at the beginning of the year. Auditor Cindy Stein explained that the county has already received a bid for demo so it will have to be pulled. Update on the Pruitt property was also given by Barnes. Barnes explained the home owner is asking for permission to retrieve belongings inside the home. Barnes went on to explain that the house is in complete disarray and too dangerous to allow entrance. Equipment for the demo is already onsite. Update on the new parking lot on Boonville where property was recently demoed was given. Barnes explained that Highway has rolled the lot for screws and nails and later this afternoon will begin striping. The fence around the lot is set to be picked up either this Friday or following Monday. Property located near Pearson Creek and farm road 44, is currently owned by the bank and sits in a flood plain. The county is working on purchasing the property.
