OEM Director Larry Wood informed the Commission that he was recently on a conference call regarding mitigation planning and explained so of the concerns on the suggest format. EMP grant funds are up a total of 30k from last year and whenever possible the Presiding Commissioner will need to sign.

E911 Assistant Director JR Webb updated the Commission that 911 is in the middle of hiring new staff and are working to complete their budget for 2019.

Health Department Director Clay Goddard informed the Commission that they were recently confirmed as an accredited health department which is a huge accomplishment to receive such an award. Katie Towns assistant director explained how the Greene County Health department is a unique facility in which it was ran by both a county and a city so there are different process that they go through vs other health departments.
