**WHEREAS**, the Greene County Commission on this 7<sup>th</sup> day of January 2019, at an emergency meeting duly called, noticed and held, considers the letter of resignation of Lee Ann Walker, Greene County Public Administrator, delivered to the County Commission on January 7, 2019; and

**WHEREAS**, the County Commission is required under the provisions of Section 105.030, RSMo. to appoint a County Public Administrator to discharge the duties of the Public Administrator until the Governor fills the vacancy by appointment pursuant to Section 105.030.1, RSMo.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, on this 7<sup>th</sup> day of January, 2019, on motion duly made and seconded, the question was called on whether David Yancey should be appointed by the County Commission as the Greene County Public Administrator, after being duly qualified as provided by law, to serve as Public Administrator until the Governor fills the vacancy by appointment under Section 105.030.1, RSMo., whereupon Commissioner Bengsch voted "Yes" and Presiding Commissioner Dixon voted "Yes".

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that this Order and Appointment shall be effective upon passage by the Greene County Commission, and a copy of this Order shall be filed in the Office of the County Clerk before 5:00 p.m. this date.


