Attendees: Bob Dixon, Harold Bengsch, John Russell, Jeff Scott, Chris Coulter, Melissa Denny, Kevin Barnes, Donna Barton and Megan Applegate.

Resource Management Director Kevin Barnes informed Commission that currently Resource Management was looking for additional space in the Historic Courthouse for the Collector's Office. Booth property has been cleaned up and the county will look to recoup the money of the cleanup costs. Barnes also update the Franz Property and stated currently the Judge offered a deal of an \$8500 judgement instead of the \$10,000 that is actually owed, and informed Commission that staff will present to the Commission the agreement to sell the land (Formally the Hood Property) to Hamlin Church. Barnes and staff are also working with a company named Williams Blake Properties who have failed multiple times to get the correct permits to build and will inform Commission when he obtains additional information. Mr. Barnes stated that as of the morning there had been no reports of flooding in homes but will update the Commission if anything changes.

Budget Officer Jeff Scott briefed Commission on radio needs for OEM and the Sheriff's Office. OEM Director Larry Woods informed Commission of the approximant number of radios currently at OEM. Commissioner Russell asked Scott what amount was budgeted for replacement of radios, Scott informed Russell that 1.9 million was stated in the resolution. Scott stated that there may be a cost savings as the actual replacement costs may only be \$500, 00.00.

County Administrator Chris Coulter explained that the Commission is required to appoint two Commissioners to the Strafford TIF. Discussion ensued about which Commissioners should be appointed. Commissioner Harold Bengsch moved to approve John Russell and Bob Dixon to the Strafford TIF. Commissioner John Russell seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved Aye: Dixon, Bengsch and Russell. Nay: none Abstain: None. Absent: None. Coulter explained that two Commissioners needed to be appointed to the Springfield TIF. Commissioner Harold Bengsch moved to approve John Russell and Bob Dixon to the Springfield TIF. Commissioner John Russell seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved Aye: Dixon, Bengsch and Russell. Nay: none Abstain: None. Absent: None.

Highway Purchasing Coordinator Melissa Denny presented the Commission with 9 requests for Surplus property (Exhibit 1) 5 Dodge Chargers, 1 Ford Interceptor, 2 Chevy Tahoe's and 1 Chevy Impala. These vehicles will be placed on GOV deals. Commissioner John Russell made a motion to prove the request to sell the 9 items of surplus property on Gov deals.
