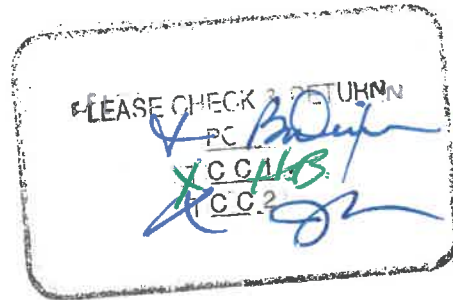

The Greene County Commission is in support of the Convention & Visitors Bureau's application for a grant from the U.S. Economic Development Administration. The funding would be used to create marketing programs that would help the area's travel and tourism industry recover from the significant decrease in travel caused by the pandemic.

In Greene County, thousands of people in the leisure and hospitality industry were laid off or furloughed beginning in March and many of them still have not been able to return to work. The U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics reports that all employment sectors in the Springfield area saw declines in employment and were down 9.6 percent in April and 7.9 percent in May. The leisure and hospitality industry, however, was hit harder than any other category with declines of 45.5 percent in April and 31.5 percent in May.

Not only are people unemployed, Smith Travel Research reports hotel revenue in May in Springfield was down more than 40 percent compared to last year, a decline that trickles down to other businesses that provide goods and services to hotels.

Clearly, the travel industry plays an important role in the local economy and its recovery is urgent. With marketing programs that increase travel to Greene County, displaced workers can return to the jobs they lost and the area's economy can recover more quickly.


Discussion has been ongoing for over a year re: the US Route 60/MO Route 125 Interchange in Greene County. The Greene County Commission was represented by Commissioner Russell at a March 5, 2020 meeting on this topic that included MoDOT representatives. The position of the Commission was stated at that time, and we reiterate our position with this letter.


Many concepts have been presented and while the community preferred the original Concept 1 design, a compromise option was pursued in Concept 3. This concept realized the same cost savings and much needed safety improvements as Concept 2 while at the same time taking into consideration community concerns, including economic development of the area, insurance premiums of homeowners (keeping from increasing their ISO protection class) and general ease of use. The Greene County Commission has received numerous contacts from constituents regarding the planned construction project at this intersection. By far, the majority of citizens contacting us are in opposition to the Concept 2 layout. Our constituents overwhelmingly prefer Concept 3. We understand that Concept 3 will have road detours in place for a longer period of time, but the superior result is well worth the short term sacrifice.


Building the interchange east of the existing intersection (Concept 2) will create a situation similar to Jamestown just west of Rogersville, where drivers must make a decision to exit Route 60 prior to actually seeing their intended destination. This debacle has contributed to difficulty in attracting businesses to the Jamestown commercial area, and the same economic detriment can be expected at Route 60 and Route 125 under Concept 2. Concept 3 allows drivers to see the businesses at the interchange and provides drivers time to exit Route 60 without driving past the exit lane.

An online public comment period/survey is not an adequate tool for a project of this magnitude and impact. Citizens deserve an opportunity to be heard. We ask that MoDOT hold an in-person public meeting and continue discussions with the City of Rogersville, Greene County, property owners and interested citizens to work toward the Concept 3 design.


