### **Farm Road 56 Speed Study Summary:**

**Location:** Farm Road 56 (between Route H and Shelby Road) – approximately 120-ft west of Bataan Ln

**Time Period:** Tuesday, November 8, 2022 thru Monday, November 14, 2022

#### **Tube Counter Data Summary:**

Average Daily Traffic Volume = 71 vehicles/day

Average Speed (EB and WB) = 29 mph

85% Speed (EB and WB) = 37 mph

#### **Magnetic Counter Data Summary:**

Average Daily Traffic Volume (EB) = 40 vehicles/day

Average Speed (EB) = 38 mph

85% Speed (EB) = 48 mph

- 21.7% of eastbound vehicles are traveling in excess of the 45 mph posted speed limit
- 9.1% of eastbound vehicles are traveling in excess of 55 mph
- 85% of eastbound vehicles are traveling at or below a speed of 48 mph
- Westbound magnetic counter failed to collect any data during the study period

**Highway Department Recommendation:** The currently posted speed limit of 45 mph is consistent with the prevailing speed of travel for 85% of the motorists traveling on Farm Road 56 between Shelby Road and Route H. We recommend that no changes be made to the regulatory speed limit on this roadway segment.
